Introduction

I have always wanted to invent a special form of divination for Demonolators. In one of my other books, “Divining and Speaking with Daemons: A Practical Guide,” I wrote a brief treatise on this idea. Here in this book, I go over the stones in more detail. I explain what element the Demon is, and what the divinatory meanings are.

The hierarchy that I use for this form of divination is the Dukante hierarchy because it was easier to pick and choose from this list than using the Goetia, which includes 72 demons. In this book, I will explain how to create Demon Stones, how to

cleanse and bless them, how to use them for divination, and a list of different spreads.

I hope that you all find this book useful and enlightening. I have done my best to make sure that this is an accurate and easy form of divination.

A Word on Hierarchies

This book is based on the Dukante hierarchy. The reason I choose the Dukante hierarchy is because I use it. Another reason is that it is easier for me to assign meanings to these Demons for divination. You can use any hierarchy that you wish, but the one I am covering in this book is Dukante's. There are sixteen chosen Demons from this hierarchy for easy reference in divination.

Other Hierarchies

Another common hierarchy is the Goetic hierarchy. I recommend picking and choosing carefully

which Demons that you wish to use for the stones.

Unfortunately, I cannot delve too much into this hierarchy because it is much more complicated and would take many years to complete. If you wish to use this hierarchy, be sure to do your research thoroughly.

A simple way to do this is to choose Demons that represent things to you, for instance, a love Demon such as Beleth, or a healing Demon such as Buer. I also recommend a copy of "Goetic Evocation," by Steve Savedow and a copy of The Goetia to further your research.

Crafting Demon Stones

The Explanation

Demon stones are a set of sixteen stones that you make yourself. The system is based on the Dukanté hierarchy, but I am sure you could make the same device with a different hierarchy, such as the Goetic. For this form of divination, you go out and find sixteen plain rocks that you like. If you cannot find plain rocks for some reason, find some small chunks of quartz and draw the sigils instead. Upon these stones, you draw the sigils of the sixteen different Demons I have listed. The stones have an upright position and a reversed position,

like Tarot cards. Place a dot at the top of the sigil. This will help determine whether the stone you are reading is a positive or negative force. Get a nice velveteen bag that will fit the stones, for storage and to draw them out.

The Process & Tips:

1. Gathering the stones.
Find sixteen smooth stones from either a craft store or a river.
Obviously, if they are found in nature, they will be more powerful.
2. Upon each stone, draw the desired sigil with a permanent ink or paint.
Be sure to add the dot to the top of the sigil so you can see whether the

meaning of the stone is upright or reversed.

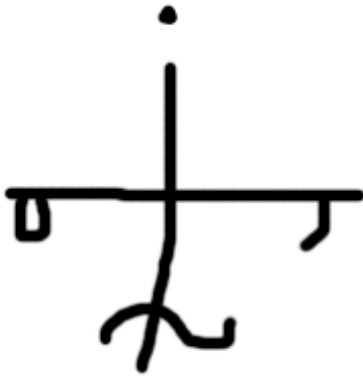
3. Perform the Consecration and Empowerment ritual as directed. This will bless and empower the stones for Demonic use. [The ritual is in a separate chapter]
4. Anoint the Demon stones with the proper oleums. This is a part of the above ritual.
5. Be sure to keep the stones in a dark place, such as a box or a velveteen type bag. You do not want light getting into the stones too much. It seems to dissipate their power for some reason.
6. Do not let anyone else touch your stones without explicit permission.

7. Cleanse and bless your stones once a year.
8. Keep your stones in a safe place, away from where other people will touch them.

This is a simple, but highly effective form of divination. You can always add your personal touch to any form that you work with. This listing is the bare bones basic for this type of divination.

On the next page is an example of how the sigils should look: (The dot on top represents the upright meaning of the stone, the dot on the bottom is the reversed meaning of the stone).

IV. Consecration and Empowerment Ritual

This ritual is designed to consecrate and empower your Demon Stones. It is a process in itself and should be utilized to make your stones as powerful as possible. This ritual is done *after* the stones have been made. You can use any Demon name that you feel comfortable with. This ritual was tailored specifically for the Dukante and Goetic hierarchies but feel free to change names if desired.

What you will need:

- The finished Demon Stones
- Usual ritual tools (dagger, candles, incense burner, offering/burning bowl, bowl of sea salt, bowl of water – or one container for both)
- Oleum of Delepitore or Azlyn (Dukante) or Vassago (Goetic) – recipes down below
- Incense of Benzoin
- Lancet or other sharp implement
- Bowl of dirt
- Extra bowl of salted water
- One red candle in a holder

Notes for Ritual

Oleum recipes:

Delepitore – Mugwort, Hibiscus, Ground Ivy, Yarrow.

Azlyn – Calamus, Rose, Jasmine, Camphor.

Vassago – Lemon Balm, Cedar, Saffron, Gum Arabic.

Enns for the ritual:

Delepitore's enn: Deyen pretore ramec Delepitore on ca.

Azlyn's enn: Rean par tasa Azlyn ayar.

No enn for Vassago is known.

The Dirt and the Water

The bowl of dirt and the bowl of consecrated salt water

must be prepared beforehand with a few drops of your blood.

The Ritual:

Arrange the items on your altar in a pleasing fashion. Place the bowl of dirt in the center, the bowl of water to the left, and the incense burner to the right. Place your other tools wherever you like. Cast your usual Demonic circle.

Invoke either Delepitore, Azlyn, or Vassago.

Invoke Satan from the center. Take each stone, one by one, and pass it through the smoke of the incense. Say:

“This stone is consecrated in the name of

Delepitore/Azlyn/Vassago [or other Demon name].”

When finished with the consecration, take each stone in hand (your power hand) and empower it with your life force. Feel the tingling of each stone in your hand. Now, pass the stone through the flame of the red candle. Say:

“In the name of [Delepitore/Azlyn/Vassago or other Demon name], I empower these stones for the purpose of divination. By this flame, this stone is sealed.”

When it feels right, place the stones in the bowl of dirt. All sixteen stones should stay in the dirt for one day.

Thank the Demons and close the ritual.

The next day, open your Demonic circle again. Take each stone and place it into the bowl of water. The stones should stay in the blessed water for a day.

The Oleum Rite

After the stones are consecrated and empowered, adding the oleums is the next step. In a Demonic circle with your choice of Demons present, take the oleum that you want to use for divination and anoint each stone carefully. Place them on to a dry towel for a few hours and then add them into their velveteen bag.

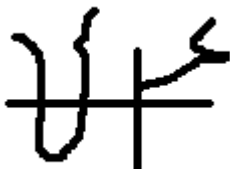
It is done.

V. **The Sixteen Demon Stones: Attributes**

Note: When reading the Demon Stones, the positive attribute is read when the stone is facing right side up. When the stone is reversed (dot side down), the negative or hidden aspects of the stone is read. Any Goetic references are here for historical purposes, not necessarily for divinatory purposes.

Belial



Element:

Earth - Dukante hierarchy;
Fire - Goetic hierarchy.

Divinatory attributes:

Belial represents the physical or tactile world. He is stability in all forms. If you draw this stone in a reading, it may be telling you that you need stability in your mundane life. It may also

signify prosperity coming to you or a new job.

Also, Belial represents a need for balance in the Earth element. In the Goetia, Belial distributes presentations and titles, reconciles friends and enemies, and provides “familiaris.” So if you draw Belial’s sigil, you may be up for a distinguished award or something in an honorary fashion. Negative or hidden aspects of this stone are: A lack of stability; can lead to flighty, fickle behavior. Misplaced anger, stubbornness.

Money:

Positive Aspect -You may be getting a raise or promotion, or a possible new job.

Negative or Hidden Aspect –
Financial trouble, gambling
behavior, loss of job.

Love:

Positive Aspect – A down-to-
earth love interest, physical
attraction, sensuality, return of
affections.

Negative or Hidden Aspect –
Fickle or picky lover, excessive
sex drive, unstable behavior,
enemies.

Mental:

Positive Aspect – Concrete
thought, common sense, ability
to make difficult decisions.

Negative or Hidden Aspect –
Lack of common sense,

unpredictability, gloom,
sullenness, dejected.

Physical:

Positive Aspect – Healthy,
strong body, endurance.

Negative or Hidden Aspect –
Problems with the throat, knees,
stomach or large intestine. Stress
and anxiety.

Spiritual:

Positive Aspect – Grounding,
practical, fertile, wisdom,
growth.

Negative or Hidden Aspect -
Stubborn, ego-maniac, misuse of
power over other people.

Lucifer



Element:

Air – Dukante hierarchy;
Other Satanic hierarchies

Divinatory Attributes:

The mind, mental
processes, enlightenment,

knowledge, new beginnings. If you draw Lucifer's sigil, you may be seeking some kind of conventional knowledge. Especially: the professions of medicine, mathematics, science of all kinds as well as writing. Lucifer also represents some kind of new beginning, sometimes the urge to go back to school for further learning. Lucifer's sigil also means that you may be starting over in some aspect of your life. Positive aspects of this stone are: Intelligence, creativity, freedom of thought, unconventional but interesting behavior, new lease on life. The negative or hidden aspects of this stone are: The inability to analyze yourself, being a know-it-all, not listening to sound advice, rebellion.

Money:

Positive Aspects – Newly open doors of opportunity, increase of cash flow from creative endeavors, ingenuity for making money.

Negative or Hidden Aspects - Throwing money around indiscriminately, fraud, embezzlement, frivolity, craving for status.

Love:

Positive Aspects – A new relationship, either platonic or a new sex partner.

Negative or Hidden Aspects – Does not indicate a true love affair, just a fling.

Mental:

Positive Aspects – Creativity, intelligence, ability to make friends and influence people, new ideas, mental empowerment.

Negative or Hidden Aspects – Flight of thought, inability to separate reality from imagination, rudeness, tactlessness.

Physical:

Positive Aspects – Healthy person, exuberance, lots of energy.

Negative or Hidden Aspects – Trouble with circulation, especially in the heart and legs, predisposition for blood clots and heart attacks.

Spiritual:

Positive Aspects –

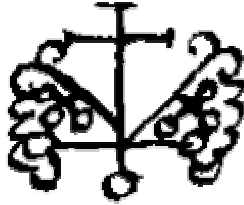
Enlightenment, spiritual
consciousness, meditative ability,
divinatory gifts.

Negative or Hidden Aspects –

“Chosen one” syndrome,
egotistical, false sense of
spiritual power, constant
changing of belief systems.

Flereous/Flauros



Element:

Fire – Dukante hierarchy;

Fire – Goetic hierarchy

Divinatory Attributes:

Sudden changes,
hastiness, determination.

Drawing Flereous' sigil indicates a change of some sort, usually sudden or unexpected. Also, this

stone can represent great passion, love, and sometimes obsession for another person or project. Fast action is common with this stone. In the Goetia, Flereous/Flauros declares things past, present and future. He also answers questions and can kill men by fire. Positive aspects of this stone include: Love, passion, change for the better, getting things done, creative action, strong willpower. The negative or hidden aspects of this stone are: Hastiness, obsession, unhealthy ego, narcissism, hatred.

Money –

Positive Attributes - Fast cash or inheritance possible. Earning money by doing something that you love to do.

Negative or Hidden Attributes

– Spendthrift, irresponsible with money, stuck in a financial rut.

Love –

Positive Attributes – Strong love or passion for a special someone - though not necessarily a long term relationship, fidelity, loyalty.

Negative or Hidden Attributes

– Unfaithfulness, argumentativeness, uncontrolled lust.

Mental –

Positive Attributes – A go-getter, highly qualified individual, mentally sharp and witty, loves a challenge.

Negative or Hidden Attributes

– Type A Personality, a workaholic, tactless, rude, insecure.

Physical –

Positive Attributes – A very physical person, both mentally and sexually. Vibrant. Full of life.

Negative or Hidden Attributes

– Obsessive-compulsive behavior, problems with the head, back, spine, heart, liver, hips, and thighs.

Spiritual –

Positive Attributes – Forging ahead on a new spiritual path, discovering your inner qualities, magical ability.

absorbing material, staying in
one place spiritually, loss of
faith.

Leviathan



Element:

Water – Dukante hierarchy, other Satanic hierarchies

Divinatory Meanings:

The flow of life, dealing with emotions, the passing of fear, judgment, detecting lies, faith. Drawing Leviathan's sigil typically represents the emotional aspect of your question. How do you feel about it? Also, this stone represents the flow of all things, natural processes and change. It can also mean fear. Are you afraid of

change? Are you passing judgment on anyone? Negative or hidden aspects of this stone can mean that someone is lying to you, especially if the stone is reversed. It can also indicate hidden enemies.

Money –

Positive Attributes – Growth of funds through a natural flow of energy – giving back to the world means you will get positive energy back as well.

Negative or Hidden Attributes – Emotional ties to money in unhealthy ways, envy of other people's money or possessions.

Love –

Positive Attributes – Beginning of a new relationship,

reciprocated love, emotional balance between partners, deep affection.

Negative or Hidden Attributes

– Loneliness, depression, loss of hope and faith in other people.

Mental –

Positive Attributes – Finding truth, empathy, judgment in your favor (in legal cases), wisdom, honesty, creative nature, the beginning of a new project.

Negative or Hidden Attributes

– Oversensitivity to stimulus, mood swings, irrational behavior, clinginess, neediness, telling lies, over-embellishing.

Physical –

Positive Attributes – Robust health and long life. Healing from an illness.

Negative or Hidden Attributes
– Problems with the lungs, breasts, or reproductive organs. Heightened sensitivity to emotional distress and anxiety that manifests in various physical problems such as chronic pain and fibromyalgia.

Spiritual –

Positive Attributes – Psychic abilities, counseling talent, able to ascend into other planes of existence easily (astral travel, ascension), prophetic dreams, a natural magician.

– Dependant on other people,
imbalanced energy, doubtful,
confused.

Satan



Element:

All – Dukante hierarchy;

Fire – Other Satanic hierarchies

Divinatory Meanings:

All wisdom, the universe, completion. If you draw Satan's

sigil, the universe is on your side. You are going with the flow. Wisdom is within you. Also, a completion of a project or a change may be headed your way. In Demonolatry, Satan is seen as the Whole, the All. By drawing this sigil, you are reminded that you are a part of the Whole of all things. Satan can also represent rebellion from the conventional. Autonomy and independence from other people. Sometimes, drawing Satan's sigil can be a warning of sorts, especially if other sigils come up at the same time – mainly other fire element Demons. This can be a warning of acting dangerously or impulsively and letting other people push you around. The only real negative aspect of this stone is that Satan is all positive and all negative. If he is the

whole of creation, he is also the whole of destruction.

This sigil does not have attributes for money, love, mental or physical matters. This is because with Satan, all things are one. The only attribute that is significant is the spiritual aspect. If you draw Satan's sigil in a spiritual reading, he is guiding you to his path. He is opening spiritual doors for you. This means to go investigate your path. Study whatever religion or system that interests you. Satan is here to be a guide and a teacher.

Verrine



Element:

Airy part of Water – Dukante hierarchy

Divinatory Meanings:

The positive polarity of life, healing, protection, medicine. If you draw this sigil, you may need some type of healing, whether physical, mental, emotional, or spiritual. Oftentimes, you may have a polarity imbalance that is causing your illness. This sigil also represents spiritual protection – typically from the Demons

themselves. Verrine is a positive polarity Demon, which means that he still has negative or hidden aspects but these are not as serious as a negative polarity Demon such as Amducious would be. These negative or hidden aspects would be impatience, cruelty, and illness.

Money –

Positive Attributes: Positive cash flow from hard work.

Negative or Hidden Attributes
– Loss of money through illness.

Love –

Positive Aspects – A love that encourages you to become a better and healthier person.

Demon Stones

Negative or Hidden Aspects – Animosity and impatience with a lover.

Mental –

Positive Attributes – Thinking with a clear head.

Negative or Hidden Attributes – Disconnectedness, chaotic thinking.

Physical –

Positive Attributes – Healing from an illness, becoming whole again.

Negative or Hidden Attributes – Physical strain and illness, polarity imbalance, inner turmoil.

Spiritual –

Positive Attributes – Empathic and sympathetic person, ability to heal psychically as well as physically. A person drawn to the medical profession for humanitarian purposes instead of monetary ones.

Negative or Hidden Attributes – Unsympathetic, insensitive person, inability to heal the self. It is wise to seek medical counsel if this stone is drawn in this position.

Amducious



Element:

Watery part of Fire – Dukante hierarchy;

Air – Goetic hierarchy

Divinatory Meanings:

Negative polarity of life, destroyer, disaster, negative feelings, holding in emotions, release of fear. If you draw this sigil, you may be feeling a large

amount of negativity in your life right now. Things may be turning for the worse. But remember, this is only temporary. This stone is telling you that you may be holding in emotions that you should not – and Amducious is warning you to let go or you may explode. This stone is evident of hard times in one's life, but as long as balance is sought, all things will pass. In the Goetia, he causes musical instruments to be heard (therefore a favorite Demon of musicians) and he causes trees to bend at command. Negative or hidden aspects to this stone are mainly some type of destructiveness in your situation.

Money –

Positive Attributes – Possible inheritance through a death or a change in the family.

Negative or Hidden Attributes
– Significant reduction in funds.

Love –

Positive Attributes – Passion and lust for another person.

Negative or Hidden Attributes
– Codependent relationship.

Mental –

Positive Attributes – Finding mental balance, shedding of destructive emotions.

Negative or Hidden Attributes
– Mental imbalance, holding on

of fears and negative thoughts and emotions.

Physical –

Positive Attributes – Fixing imbalances in one's physical makeup. Drug or medical therapy to maximize health.

Negative or Hidden Attributes – Illness due to destructive emotions.

Spiritual –

Positive Attributes – Attunement to the negative polarity, spiritual balance through examining faults in personality or physical form.

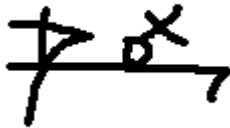
Negative or Hidden Attributes – Harnessing too much negative energy, disastrous results when

Unsere



Element – Watery part of Earth
– Dukante hierarchy

Divinatory Meaning:

This stone represents growth, fertility, life, positive change, motherhood, family. When drawing this stone, it represents all types of abundance and fecundity. You may be thinking of starting a family and buying a permanent place to live. With this stone, creativity is heightened. Happiness is coming to you. You are growing in spirituality. Any magic or ritual

that you have performed will manifest in a positive manner. Negative or hidden aspects of this stone include suspension of activities or magic, slow change, inertia, possible infertility.

Money –

Positive Attributes –

Comfortable existence with the job that you have. Stable money matters.

Negative or Hidden Attributes

– Unhappiness with a job or a money situation. Seeking money that is not feasible (i.e. like winning a lottery).

Love –

Positive Attributes – You may meet a new partner or a present

relationship may become more serious and grow.

Negative or Hidden Attributes

– A possible break up due to incompatible interests.

Mental –

Positive Attributes – Growth in intelligence, new learning experience, fertile imagination.

Negative or Hidden Attributes

– Suspension, pitfalls, slowing of mental processes.

Physical –

Positive Attributes – Possible marriage or pregnancy.

Negative or Hidden Attributes

- Decline of marriage proposal, infertility, problems with

reproductive organs and the base chakra.

Spiritual –

Positive Attributes – Mastery of sorcery and magic, positive ritual or magical results.

Negative or Hidden Attributes
– Magical failure due to lack of follow up in the real world.

Eurynomous



Element: Earth – Dukante hierarchy

Divinatory Meaning:

This stone represents the death of something, not necessarily a physical death. Typically, it is the death of attached emotions, fears, and anger. This sigil also means that a major change of some sort is about to happen. Other aspects of this stone are: spiritual transformation of the soul, peace with oneself, and connection to ancestry. If physical death does

occur, then the person who has passed on will be happy and released from any fears that were attached to them while living. This stone usually represents a positive change, unless there is an underlying tide of negativity.

Money –

Positive Attributes – Letting go of materialism.

Negative or Hidden Attributes
– Becoming too obsessed with money and material things.

Love –

Positive Attributes – A change for the better in relationships.

Negative or Hidden Attributes
- Stalemate. Inability to maintain relationships.

Mental –

Positive Attributes – Letting go of harmful thoughts and actions.

Negative or Hidden Attributes
– Holding on to the past.

Physical –

Positive Attributes – Change in health and appearance.

Negative or Hidden Attributes
– Sickness, sorrow.

Spiritual –

Positive Attributes – Transformation of the soul, finding one's path to enlightenment. Honoring of

ancestors/family, passing on
familial traditions.

Negative or Hidden Attributes
– Spiritually lost. Straying from a
chosen path. Seeking validation.

Belphegore



Element: Earth – Dukante hierarchy

Divinatory Meaning:

This stone represents material gain, jobs, prosperity, stability in home and work. If you draw this sigil, you may be either coming into money or getting a new job, especially one that fits you very well. Also, this sigil means that you may have found your true calling in life. Negative or hidden aspects of this sigil are: Greed, hoarding, selfishness, lack of conscience.

Money –

Positive Attributes – Material gain, new job, prosperity.

Negative or Hidden Attributes
– Hoarding, greed, selfishness.

Love –

Positive Attributes – Prosperous love affair, may or may not be permanent.

Negative or Hidden Attributes
– Overindulgence in sensual pleasures.

Mental –

Positive Attributes – “Get ahead” attitude. Positive self-worth.

Negative or Hidden Attributes

– Becoming too wrapped up in getting ahead. False self-worth.

Physical –

Positive Attributes – Sturdy body, abundant health.

Negative or Hidden Attributes

– Gluttony.

Spiritual –

Positive Attributes – In tune with the Earth's energies, magic is abound, mysterious happenings.

Negative or Hidden Attributes

– Feeling out of sorts, disassociated.

Rosier



Element: Water – Dukante hierarchy

Divinatory Meaning:

Unconditional love, understanding, happy marriage. Definite long-term relationships. This stone indicates true love, finding your soul mate. Also indicates self-love and patience. The negative or hidden aspects of this stone are selfishness, shyness, being desperate, seeking attention.

Money –

Positive Attributes - None.

Negative or Hidden Attributes
– None.

Love –

Positive Attributes – As above.

Negative or Hidden Attributes
– As above.

Mental -

Positive Attributes – Becoming a loving person, knowing your wants and desires in a relationship, patience.

Negative or Hidden Attributes
– Love for selfish gain, wishy-washy.

Demon Stones

Physical –

Positive Attributes – Happiness, a contagious glow, hyperactivity.

Negative or Hidden Attributes
– Blinded by love.

Spiritual -

Positive Attributes – Love for mankind, the universe.

Negative or Hidden Attributes
– Spiritual wallflower – by this I mean someone who is spiritual but stays hidden for fear of emotional pain or dissonance from others.

Element: Earthy part of Water –
Dukante hierarchy

Divinatory Meanings:

Wisdom of the self and the universe, divination, sorcery/magic, the path we tread – the terra we walk upon, the right way to go. If you draw this stone, the answer to your question is most likely a “yes.” This stone represents true wisdom, success in magic and sorcery, psychic gifts, empathy, finding one’s purpose in life. Negative or hidden aspects of

this stone include: Disconnection with the Demons, loss of purpose, close-mindedness, lack of common sense, magical backfire, and if drawn reversed, the answer to your question is likely a “no.”

Money –

Positive Attributes - Gain of money from spiritual pursuits such as tarot reading or making magical crafts.

Negative or Hidden Attributes
– Loss of money from fraudulent spiritual pursuits, or from misusing your gifts for personal gain.

Love –

Positive Attributes – True love through wisdom and spirituality.

Demon Stones

Negative or Hidden Attributes

– Lack of common sense in love matters.

Mental –

Positive Attributes – Clear thinking and open-mindedness to spirituality.

Negative or Hidden Attributes

– Cloudy judgment.

Physical –

Positive Attributes – Balanced physical health, equilibrium.

Negative or Hidden Attributes

– Decline in energy due to imbalanced ritual.

Element: Fiery part of Earth –
Dukante hierarchy

Divinatory Meaning:

Battle, upheaval, chaos, internal hatred, cursing. When this stone is drawn, you may be going through a growth period of intense and sudden change. You probably feel like your whole world has been turned upside down and you are ready for some type of battle. Jealousy may be prominent at this time, usually stemming from another person who has something that you want

or need. You may be feeling an intense hatred for another person. When this sigil is drawn, this is the time to get out your cursing implements. Negative or hidden aspects of this stone are: Jealousy, hatred, disgust, backfiring curses.

Money –

Positive Attributes – Sudden, unplanned, material gain.

Negative or Hidden Attributes
– Material gain through destruction of another person.

Love –

Positive Attributes – Instant attraction.

Negative or Hidden Attributes

– Disgust for a conventional lover.

Mental –

Positive Attributes – When the going gets tough, the tough get going.

Negative or Hidden Attributes

– Total destruction of preconceived notions and expectations, but in a dangerous way (i.e. the tearing down of the ego).

Physical –

Positive Attributes – Feeling ready for anything.

Negative or Hidden Attributes

– Tired, stressed out, and anxious.

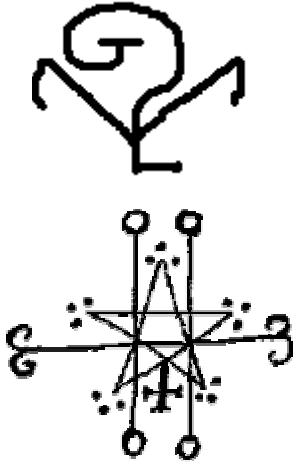

Element: Earth – both Dukante and Goetic hierarchy

Divinatory Meaning:

If you draw this stone, it means that you may be influenced by a friend, or are seeking platonic relationships. This stone may also represent

love relationships, but you will have to be friends first. Another possibility when drawing this sigil is that you are starting on your spiritual quest. Ashtaroth is very helpful for all these matters of love, friendship, and spiritual understanding. Negative or hidden aspects of this stone are: Inability to maintain relationships, bashfulness, and a beginner upon the spiritual path to enlightenment. In the Goetia, Ashtaroth declares things past, present, and future, answers questions, discovers all secrets, and teaches the liberal sciences.

Money –

Positive Attributes –
Maintaining a financial
friendship.

Negative or Hidden Attributes

– Borrowing money from friends and not paying it back.

Love –

Positive Attributes – Great friend, positive role model.

Negative or Hidden Attributes

– No chance for a serious relationship unless friendship comes first.

Mental –

Positive Attributes – Grasping spiritual ideas.

Negative or Hidden Attributes

– Abandoning past notions and becoming attached to a path before one is ready.

Physical –

Positive Attributes – A person of great beauty who is attracted to you.

Rofocale/Focalor**



Element:

Air – Dukante hierarchy;

Water – Goetic hierarchy

Divinatory Meaning:

Positively, this stone represents taking control of your destiny, change, power, mastery, gain. Lucifuge is also known as Focalor in the Goetia. When you draw this stone, it is rather significant because it is time to take over your own destiny and make it a positive and powerful change. Negative or hidden aspects of this stone are: Obsession with power, manipulation of other people, tearing other people down to make the ego stronger. In the Goetia, Focalor drowns men, sinks ships of war, causes winds and rough seas.

Money –

Positive Attributes – Making money on your own terms.

Negative or Hidden Attributes

– Gouging money, hiding and hoarding, drowning in debt.

Love –

Positive Attributes – Personal power over love life.

Negative or Hidden Attributes

– The feeling that your self-worth is nothing without another person.

Mental –

Positive Attributes – An “I can do it!” attitude.

Negative or Hidden Attributes

– Sarcastic, depressed and rude attitude over every aspect of life.

Physical –

Positive Attributes – Strength in the total self.

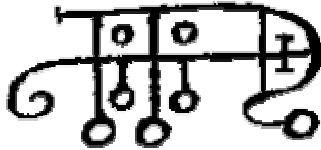
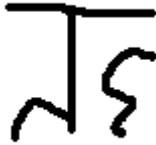
Negative or Hidden Attributes

Education, book smarts, college, writing, creativity. If you draw this stone, you may be contemplating going back to school. Also, you may be experiencing a creative burst of

energy when it comes to your writing or other art. Knowledge is the key to this sigil, whether it is inner knowledge or knowledge that you learn from books. Drawing this stone means that you are seeking enlightenment through a gift of writing, languages, math, art, science, etc. Not to mention, you may also be seeking a great spiritual understanding as well. Negative or hidden aspects of this stone are: Being a know-it-all, sarcasm, distaste for stupidity, and hiding your emotions beneath a cool, aloof shell.

Money –

Positive Attributes – Ability to earn money in many different ways. Versatile.

Negative or Hidden Attributes

– Not careful when it comes to spending, or a total cheap tightwad.

Love –

Positive Attributes – A smart, spiritually minded soul mate.

Negative or Hidden Attributes

– Sarcastic, aloof person.

Mental –

Positive Attributes – Very quick witted and friendly.

Negative or Hidden Attributes

– Tends to backstab.

Physical –

Positive Attributes – Looks for inner beauty instead of physical perfection.

Negative or Hidden Attributes
– Misses the whole point of a physical relationship. Only sees the mental side of things.
Detached sexually.

Spiritual –

Positive Attributes – Seeking enlightenment through various forms of knowledge. Works when the muse strikes.

Negative or Hidden Attributes
– Strong distaste for non-spiritual people.

This concludes the section on the sixteen Demon Stones. Some of the meanings may or may not make sense to you. All forms of divination, however, are open to interpretation by the diviner her/himself.

VI. Spreads

In this book, I include five different spreads to use for divination.

1. Four Stone Reading – A simple reading, for any purpose. The first stone represents the mental aspect, the second, the physical aspect; the third, the spiritual aspect; the fourth, the path to tread.
2. Six Stone Reading – Another simple reading, for any purpose. The first two stones represent the past; the second two stones represent the present; the last two

stones represent the future.

3. The Astrological Reading – A complicated reading with many different parts. This is a very detailed way to read the stones. It takes some practice. Follow the instructions on the Astrological spread page.
4. The Single Stone Reading - A single stone is used to gain a quick insight into what drives the situation, or to reduce it to the most concise summary possible.
5. The Diamond Reading - The diamond spread reveals the dynamic forces at work in a

situation. It is the spread of choice for understanding a hidden conflict. You set the stones in the shape of a diamond. The bottom stone represents the foundation that forms the basis of the issue; the left stone represents one of the forces acting on the issue at hand; the right stone represents another of the forces acting on the issue at hand; the top rune represents the conclusion to which your strivings can carry you.

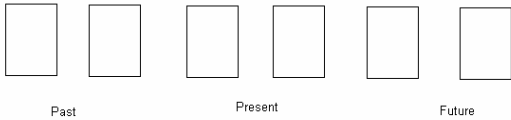

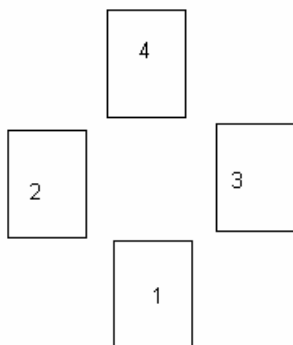

Six Stone Reading Diagram

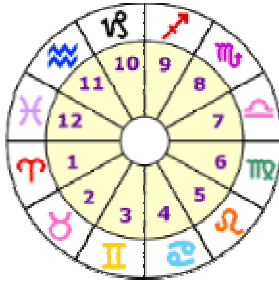

The Astrological Spread



This is a fairly common spread, usually used in tarot readings. I have modified it for use with the Demon stones. Here are the meanings of each of the houses:

1. Aries – Rules all beginnings, including childhood. It is assigned to the querent's appearance and characteristics, also her/his worldly outlook

- and potential. Key words: Personality, potential, constitution.
2. Taurus – This is the sign that conserves and builds. Concerns financial affairs and tangible assets. Key words: Financial affairs, material possessions.
 3. Gemini – This is a mental sign that links people together through like thought. It is assigned to relatives, neighbors; also to communications; letters, roads, writings, and short journey's. Key words: Mental activity, relatives, communications – especially writing.
 4. Cancer – The fourth house is assigned to all endings; Old age, old people, parents, and the home environment. Key

- words: Home and family, the father, the end of life.
5. Leo – Governs the heart. Love affairs, children, things that cause excitement; theatres, gambling, speculations. Key words: Children, love affairs, pleasures, speculations.
 6. Virgo – This house rules work, employees, food, hygiene, and the general health of the querent. Key words: Health, employees, food, health.
 7. Libra – This house rules marriage and business partners, dealings with the public, lawsuits, open enemies. Key words: Marriage, partnerships, enemies.
 8. Scorpio – Rules death, legacies, insurance

- policies; also the partner's money, sex, occult experiences. Key words: Legacies, taxes, the occult.
9. Sagittarius – Rules law, philosophy, and religion. Also dreams, psychic experiences, long journeys, and foreign countries. Key words: Philosophy, religion, dreams, ideals.
 10. Capricorn – Rules profession, promotion, fame. Also parentage and social status. Concerns government. Key words: Profession, public life, government, honor, mother.
 11. Aquarius – This house rules the friends that you have made; groups, clubs to which you belong. It

has some rule over the money you earn from your profession, financial conditions of the employer. Hopes, wishes, aspirations. Key words: Hopes, wishes, organizations, associates.

12. Pisces- Rules hidden limitations that restrict your power of expression. Secrets, secret enemies, self-undoing. This house also rules institutions; the strength or weakness of the querent's body and soul. Key words: Seclusion, self-undoing, institutions, secret enemies.

The Reading Itself

Draw a simple pie chart divided into 12 pieces, like the chart

above. Write what sign each division of the pie is. Simply shake your bag of stones and pull out one stone for each piece of the pie chart. The best way to interpret this is by reading and memorizing what each sign means, and what the stone itself means in the spot where it is drawn. You must look at all possibilities of the meanings to decipher the chart. Record the reading in your grimore. This will make it easier to decode.

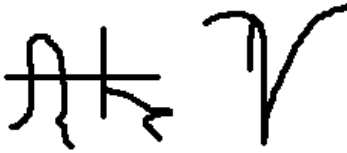
Sample Reading

For this example I will use the Six Stone spread.

Six Stone: Draw two stones for the past, two for the present, and two for the future.

Question: A 30-year-old woman who just lost her job because she demanded a raise, is looking for a new job that meets her needs and not only pays well, but allows her fun and creativity. She is very materialistic and envious of other people's possessions and wants to find a job that she can brag about to her friends. Her question is: *Am I going to find a new job that will bring me what I need the most?*

Past:

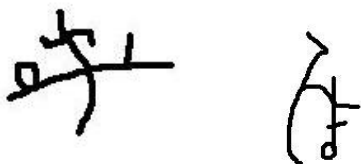


Belial, reversed – Financial trouble, loss of a job.

Eurynomous – Letting go of materialism to find the dream job.

Present:



Leviathan, reversed - Emotional ties to money in unhealthy ways, envy of other people's money or possessions.

Lucifuge – Making money on your own terms.

Future:



Belphegore – Material gain, new job, prosperity.

Amducious, reversed - A warning: Significant reduction in funds.

Outcome:

According to the reading, she has just lost her job due to demanding a raise and is having financial difficulty. She has emotional problems with spending money and jealousy issues about other people's money.

By drawing Eurynomous, she should realize that she needs to let go of this materialism to find the job that she needs.

Lucifuge represents her drive to make money on her own terms, without interference from other people.

The future indicates that she will find a new job, but by drawing Amducious, she needs to watch out for a reduction in

funds due to her emotional spending. Basically, she needs to get over the emotional money issues and the jealousy of other people's money, and find that dream job that meets her expectations.

This reading is a positive one, and it is likely that she will do very well with a new job as long as she stays stable and does not brag too much.
