## BLASTED TOWER

The Golden Dawn version of the Tower is very muth in :ine with the traditional meaning of this trump. The Tower of course should be viewed as an extension of the Devil for the two figures chained to the altar are now blasted out of the Tower through divine intervention. The archetypal meaning of this trump haz its roots in the biblical Tower of Eabel and the Fostdiluvian Kings. Df this the Zohar says: "The beginning of his (timect) Kingdom was Babel", from which we gather, it was he nho firyt seduced the Fostdiluvians from the wortip and service of tho true god, and introducing confusion and disunion amongst then, tie eventually in upsurping rule and sovereignty over then anc ise them to a plain in the land of Shinar, by which is meart, tive from that time men forsook the worship of the Divine end oegs. live in defiance of his law, then degenerated and gave themstives whally up to the pursuit of worldy pleasures and erijo, men' $=$, worshipping the creature rather than their ereator who $1=3:=0 \mathrm{a}=\mathrm{z}$ forever. It is further related "And they said, go to, 1,4, build us a city and a tower whose head may reach unto the fieaven and let us make a name..." observe the words "And they said, ge to, let us build us a city and tower whose top zlaly teat: heaven." The term"Habbah" (go to) whenever used in scriptu" $=1$. always found in connection with something or a project urireallsed by those who conceived it. Their blind impulse to tuild a city and tower arose only from wicked and foolish desire. Et..tt tuimated and prompted them to live in open revolt against the $1 \mathrm{t} \%$ One.

In the ritual of the 27 th Fath of Feh (related to Mars) tine candidate is told: Ere the Eternal instituted the Formation, Beginning and the End existed not. Therefore, before iHm, ti= expanded a certain Veil, and therein he instituted the silmai Kings and these are the kings who reigned in Edom tefore there reigned a king of Israel. But they subsisted not. When the Earth was formless and void - behold this is the reigr of Escit. And when creation was established. Lo, this is the reign of IEree:. And the Wars of Titanic forces in the Chaos of creatiun, Lo. these are the wars between then. From a Light-bearer of unsuportable brightness, proceeded aradiating flame, furling forth, like a vast and mighty Hammer, those sparks which wero the Frimiz worlds. And these sparks flamed and scintillated awhile, but being unbalanced, they were extinguished. Sincelo, the kings assembled, they passed away together, they themselves beheld so they were astonished. They feared. They hasted away. And these

At the brightest that was before Him, the thick clouds passed - Hal $1-5=2$ and flashings of fire. The lord thundered through the Hea. eng and the Highest gave forth His Voice-Hail-stones and fiazhinga er Fire. He sent his arrows and scattered them: he hurled feth $h$, lightnings and destroyed them."

This gives an indication of the background the Golden gane associated to this trump. Though a somewhat susjective viewpathe when taken in context with the Zohar it does flow bhe sata mo. 1 ing.  ing Flash proceeding from a rayed circle and terminating on a triangle. It is the Tower of Babel struck by Fire from Hea.el.. It is to be noted that the triangle at the end of the lis'taing Flash, issuing fron a circle, forms exactiy the astrantmic. symbol of Mars. It is the power of the triad rushilig tety t, troying the Columns of Darkness. Three holes ars rent ar, tte walls, symbolising the establishment of the Triac therein anc athe Crown at the summit of the Tower is falling, as the Crowns ir. thKings of Edom fell, who are also symboilsed ty the nen f.iling headlong. On the righthand side of the Tower is LIGHT, and the representation of the Tree of LIFE by the ten circles th. $\mathrm{c}=\mathrm{di}$ posed. On the left-hand side of the Tree is DAFKNEES rud ex even circies symbolising the QLIPFOTH.:

The Tower is also a symbol of man hinself with the i she of destruction being brought down upen his own heat ác totior. ? fact the Tower is the Middle Fillar, like man, having s's ris': to choose which side of the Tree it will lean to for its wport. In this instance it has drawn from martial Geburah and cuct. hey. been felt the tempest. The figures also fhow the temporery won cept of power. The important thing to realise here is that the Tower is based on a philosophy that has no true weight or ubstance, in short, dreams that can never be. The twelve points contained in the three concentric circles also stand for the unification of the twelve tribes of Israel which forces the closure of the reign of the kings of Edom. The three concertiric
circles that they are enclosed in relate to the fir Copt. fur, 16 Limitless Light from which all power must flow throug\%. The ran has five points and and is analogous to the power of tio, :1.:
 destructive.

The disk on the top right of the card has tie poirit, ait:in the Scarlet of the King Scale, as is the lightning fad at ct issues from it to destroy the Tower. The background, withi., the circle, is Foppy Red of the Queen Scale. The bactgrout of $5: 2$ card is the complementary Green (to the King Scale), on the $1=1$ : hand side of the Tower is in its depth while on the igit lierte side of the tower the Green becomes translucent. The is Sephicter are in the Madder Fed of the Frince Scale while the 10 Surhioth are Cherry Fied with an Amber circle around each and rercesers the Frincess Scale. The figures falling from the tower are the translucent colour of the king Scale with comp:ement-ry 9 , clothing. The earth on which the tower stanits is the c.r. Aeprotary Green, to the Queen Scale. The Cruwn on the Tuwer, $: 4$ Foppy Red of the Queen Scale. The tower itsel $f:-t$. Sher, $\leq$, , of the Frincess Scale with the bricks qutlined in finter. - 4 three spaces in the tower are transparent and atow, the 5 . $=1$. background coming through.

The title of the Blasted Tower is Lord of the Hests of the Mighty'. This relates to the Tower being the point of focus $f^{+}$ housing of the Kings of Edom.

The alchemical aspect of this card is the altedo. Verethe Anthor is heated to the extreme until separation occurs, illuetrated by the two bodies and the two aspects of the Tree on each side of the tower. The king (shown as the crown on the tower) has been transformed into these two melted bodies; wher reduced to ashes are joined to the fire again as the fire givos freely of
its spirit to them. As they manifestly tuke it from lhe air 1 . t makes ail things just as it mates men and all thing teta, o to them a vital spirit soul.
