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Mistakes or lies can never happen in prophecy:

Because how can mistake creep into the Light of the Truth that originates from the Creator?

Rather, it surely is like the rain and the snow that come down from heaven to earth and does not return until it accomplished what it was sent for. Although in spite of all this, there is...

...A long and short road in prophecy:

Because of course there are still distinctions between the prophets who receive messages, for there is no one in the same quality of the other, since this greatness or smallness can be seen due to the degree of preparation of that prophet.

So hereby, the lesser, inevitably because of lack of the excellent preparation, deviates the course of the light that comes to him.

So much so that it would have been possible to say about him that some mistakes crept in, except for the iron rule that the light of prophecy does not admit any mistake at all.

Yet because of his lesser degree, he attracts to himself a greater number of letter combinations, which is a greater number of channels and vessels, until the prophecy reaches his comprehension.
