The Ceremonial Wand:

- (i) The true and absolute magical wand must be one perfectly straight branch of almond or Hazel, cut at a single blow with the magical pruning knife or sickle before the rising of the sun, at the moment when the tree is ready to blossom.
- (ii) It must be pierced through its whole length without splitting or breaking it, and a long needle of magnetized iron inserted to run its length.
- (iii) To one of the extremities must be attached a polyhedral () prism, cut in a triangular shape.
- (iv) To the other end a similar figure to the above in black resin.
- (v) Two rings, one of copper and one of zinc, must be placed at the center of the wand.
- (vi) It must then be gilt from the ring to the Resin. And silvered from the ring to the prism.
- (vii) on the copper ring these characters must be engraved:

יָ רֶשֶׁת שֵׁן לָמֶד סָמֶךְ הֵן קוּפֵה רֶשֶׁת

Yod, Resh, vau, Shin, lamed, Samech, he, Quoph, Resh,
 Shin, he
 Y R V, Sh, L, S, He, Q, R, S, he.
 'Yo Rowshelashhequoshe'

- (viii) On the Zinc ring:

הֵן מֶמֶר לָמֶד רֶשֶׁת לָמֶד מֶמֶר הֵן

He, Mem, lamed, Resh, Lamed, Mem, He
 H, M, L, R, L, M, H,
 'Hemellarelambia'

Consecration:

This must last 7 days, starting at the new moon. It should be done by an initiate of the great Arcanum who has a consecrated wand.
∴ I am an initiate & I already have a consecrated

wand. This is the transmuting of the magical secret

The wand & other instruments, but especially the wand, must be concealed with care, and under no pretext should the magus permit them to be seen or touched by the profane, or they will lose all their virtue.

The length of the wand shouldn't exceed the length of the operator's arm.

The magician must never use it unless he is alone, and even then should only touch it when necessary.

The magical wand is the 'verendum' of the magician, it must not even be mentioned in any clear manner. No one should boast of its possession, and its consecration must be under conditions of absolute discretion & Confidence.
